Family Make-Up: Father, Mother, and one teenage daughter

Bed-Time: 9:30p.m.

Chores: Clean up after dinner, make your bed, and help with laundry

Entertainment: Family spends time together and they would really love for you to participate

Unspoken rules:

- Family is loud, vocal, and assertive.
- Just because family is speaking loudly doesn't mean they are mad.

Family Make-Up: Mother and one 9-year-old daughter

Bed-Time: 9:00p.m.

Chores: Take out trash, vacuum once per week

Entertainment: Television and other electronics allowed in very small increments and game time as a family is encouraged.

Unspoken rules:

- The 9 year old daughter is very sensitive
- You have learned no to joke with her or you'll upset her and feel badly

School: Central Middle School

Family Make-Up: Mother, father and 2 grown children who are out of the home

Bed-Time: 9:15p.m.

Chores: Clean up after dinner and help cook once per week.

Entertainment: The older children come home one night per week and the whole family eats dinner together. Everyone is requested to stay out in the dining and living room with the group until the dinner is over.

Unspoken rules: This is a light-hearted, upbeat group. It seems like they are happy about most things, so occasionally you feel bad for being so sad about your family.

Family Make-Up: Mother, step-father, 10-year old twins (one boy and one girl)
